

3rd Grade Summer Reading Assignment

Students will choose **1 chapter book** to read and complete the "Story Sequencing Book Report".

(Directions for completing the sequencing activity along with an example are attached.)

Students may read a chapter book of their **choice** that is on or above the reading lexile of 450 which is equivalent to the Accelerated Reader level of 2.5 and above.

The following chapter books are just some examples of different series of titles that would fall into these areas to give you some ideas: *Amelia Bedelia*, *American Girl*, *Boxcar Children*, *Magic Tree House*, *Fly Guy*, and *Hardy Boys*.

It is very important for students to continue to read over the summer break! Students are also asked to read at least **10 books** of their choice and add them to the attached "**Summer Reading Log**" to be turned in along with their book report. These books can be picture books, but should be on an Accelerated Reader level of 2.0 or greater!

I am looking forward to seeing all of the books that you read this summer as well as having the opportunity to read along with you in 3rd grade! Hope you all have a wonderful summer!!

Sequencing Book Report

Materials Needed:

- 5 index cards
- 24 inch strip of ribbon, yarn, or construction paper
- crayons and glue or tape

Directions:

1. On one index card, write the title and author.
2. Choose **four** important events from the story.
3. On each of the four remaining index cards, write one sentence about the event and draw and color a picture to go with it.
4. Arrange the cards in the order the events happened.
5. Glue or tape the index cards on a strip of ribbon, yarn, or construction paper.
