



Ongoing Activities

- AP and Dual Enrollment meetings for students and parents
- AP and Dual Enrollment advisement and registrations prior to each semester
 - Career exploration in grades 7 and up (GAfutures)
 - Elementary/middle career exploration
 - College tours during the Fall and Spring
 - Groups (conflict resolution, etc.)
- Guidance activities that include reviewing college majors, admissions requirements online
 - Visits from college admissions representatives
- Visits from community representatives to discuss topics related to health and safety
 - Workshops for elementary, middle, and high school students related to life skills, organization/time management, coping skills, financial management (school/community resources)
 - Parent-teacher conferences- scheduled as needed

- **Club Activities**- 4-H, Senior Beta Club, and Junior Beta Club service projects
- **Candler Youth Leadership**- for residents of Candler County in grades 10th through 12th
- **Fulford Youth Leadership Academy**- select students must be in 10th through 12th
- **Citizen's Bank Student Advisory Board**- students apply in 11th grade for participation in the 12th grade
